Year 2060	92,287	34,078	5
Difference	12,698	9,831	1

- All vacant land is projected to be consumed by development by 2060, including lands not necessarily accessible by automobile.
- The percent of the region (in this case the county) projected to become urban is the lowest in the state because the great majority of Monroe County contains Everglades National Park.
